	LAWN: Aerate, reseed, fertilize
	TREES AND SHRUBS: prune, plant new
	YARD TOOLS: clean and winterize
	IRRIGATION SYSTEM: drain, turn off
	FAUCETS: cover, disconnect hoses
	INSPECT: roof, siding, windows
	CLEAN GUTTERS
	DECK: stain or seal
	OUTDOOR FURNITURE: cover or store
	OUTDOOR LIGHTING: switch to LEDs
	SEAL GAPS
	SNOWBLOWER: change the oil, test, inspect

FURNACE: schedule inspection and service
AIR FILTER: replace
WINDOW AC: remove and store
CHECK SAFETY EQUIPMENT: smoke detectors, carbon monoxide sensors, fire extinguishers
RADON GAS: schedule testing
FIREPLACE/CHIMNEY: schedule inspections and cleaning; re-stock firewood
FIX AIR LEAKS
STOCK UP: ice melt, batteries, emergency supplies, non-perishable foods
INSTALL: programmable thermostat
