Solarity's Chief Information Officer, Chad Ritchie explained Apple Pay best when he said, "Apple Pay is a simple way to make purchases with the cards you already have on the device you already use. You simply hold the top of your device near a reader, place your thumb on Touch ID, wait for the vibration and *voila*, you have paid for your item. Since your card details are never shared when you use Apple Pay, using it on your iPhone, Apple Watch, or iPad is a safe and private way to pay."
